**Notes:**

Although the Department of Health pays for fees in years 5 & 6, **Scottish domiciled** students should apply to SAAS for support as they administer the arrangement for the Department of Health. **English, Welsh and N. Irish** students should apply directly to the appropriate NHS Bursary Unit for bursary support and to local authority for other grants.

**EU** students are entitled only to tuition fee support and should contact the NHS Bursary Unit in England for information.

For 2015 fees in English Medical Schools will be in the region of £9,000 per annum for home/EU students.
